

Knowledge Fundamental to the Middle Way

This composition by Nagarjuna, *Prajñā-nāma-mūlamadhyamakakārikā*, which is the most famous and important treatise on Madhyamaka philosophy, lays the foundation for the Self-empty Madhyamaka school, དབུ་མ་རང་སྟོང་།

It has twenty-seven chapters and not only has Rinpoche taught this text extensively on many occasions, but excerpts from each chapter have been collected forming the publication entitled *Sun of Wisdom*, ཤེས་རབ་ཉི་མ།

In this book, Rinpoche also draws explanations from the *Heart of Wisdom Sutra*, from Chandrakirti's *Entering the Middle Way* and Milarepa's *Authentic Portrait of the Middle Way*, in this way showing the unanimity of the words of the Buddha and the greatest Indian and Tibetan masters.
