

In Praise of Dharmadhatu

The great pandit, Nagarjuna, who is most commonly renowned for explaining the nature of mind according to the second turning of the wheel of dharma, here praises the nature of mind in accord with the third turning, describing it as clear light.

This text, in Sanskrit *Dharmadhātustava*, is the foremost of Nagarjuna's Collection of Praises, and provides in this way a bridge between the teachings on emptiness and buddha nature.
