At the beginning of his activity in the West, Rinpoche often chose to teach excerpts from a variety of sutra.

As his students grew more accustomed to Dharma, in his great kindness, Rinpoche emphasized the treatises by Indian and Tibetan masters, since they condense the essential meaning taught by the Buddha, in this way making them easier to comprehend.

Even though Rinpoche over and over again quotes the supreme being, the Buddha, it is teaching sessions based primarily on sutras that you will find in this category.
